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Activity:

This is an excellent oral comprehension and reading activity.

This is the real story of Chiman, who came to the UK as an asylum seeker from Lebanon. She is now about to begin her career as a teacher here in the UK, having just completed her training at Goldsmiths University.

- 1) Open the PPT (Chiman_histoire_sansphotos.ppt)
- 2) Slide by slide, read out Chiman’s story. You could also ask students to read out her story.
- 3) After the activity, discuss Chiman’s story in the target language. Are there questions you would like to ask Chiman? What might her answers be?

Pictures/photos:

The original PPT contained personal photographs of Chiman and her family, which we are not publishing in the public domain.

Possible extension activities could be:

- to research published photographs of migrants or asylum seekers appropriate for each sentence;
- running a photographic project in which students provide photos from their own lives to match the story
- to ask students to write their own story, inspired by Chiman’s, using their own photographs;
- to create a collage, or drawing, inspired by the story.
